

(440) From points north of Bayonne, New Jersey:

Take the New Jersey Turnpike South, crossing along New Jersey Turnpike Extension Bridge over Newark Bay, to Exit 14A (Bayonne). After tollbooth, bear left at traffic light and proceed straight ahead to Avenue E. Continue on Avenue E until you reach 12th street. Make a right at 12th street and continue for 3 blocks until you reach JFK Boulevard. Pelosi Medical Center is located between 11th and 12th street on JFK Boulevard.

### From New Jersey points south of Bayonne, New Jersey:

Take the New Jersey Turnpike North to Exit 14A (Bayonne). After tollbooth, bear left at traffic light and proceed straight ahead to Avenue E. Continue on Avenue E until you reach 12th street.
